

## Arkansas State University-Jonesboro Concurrent Program Admission Standards

All students must have **one of the reading scores outlined below and a minimum high school GPA of 2.75 for admission to the CEP.** A 900 on the SAT with a minimum GPA is also accepted. Enrollment in English composition and math courses are subject to the required subtest scores noted below.
