


HOW DO I KNOW IF I'M IN GOOD ACADEMIC STANDING (UG)



Academic Probation: When you earn below a 2.0 GPA in your current semester, or your GPA falls below 2.0. You will still be allowed to register for full term hours, but will be on academic probation during the next semester.

First Suspension: You must sign up with University Advising Center for Restart@AState by the Friday before school starts. This is the only way to allow you to stay in classes the next term. ***If you fail to enroll in Restart@AState, you will not be allowed to register for classes or live on campus. To maintain legal immigration status, this means you must leave the country and return home during this time or transfer to another school during this time.***

Second Suspension: You are suspended from A-State for one calendar year. This means that you cannot register for classes or live on campus. ***To maintain legal immigration status, this means you must leave the country and return home during this time or transfer to another school during this time. At the end of one calendar year, you may reapply for admission, and appeal through the Appeals Committee to reenroll at A-State.***

Third Suspension: You are suspended from A-State for one calendar year. This means that you cannot register for classes or live on campus. ***To maintain legal immigration status, this means you must leave the country and return home during this time or transfer to another school during this time. At the end of one calendar year, you may reapply for admission and appeal through the Appeals Committee to reenroll at A-State.***

Academic Suspension: If you were on probation during the previous term, and your current semester and cumulative GPA both fall below 2.0, you will be placed on academic suspension.
