- ◆ Overall GPA  $\geq$  2.7 (after 8/10/15)
- ◆ Completion of following courses with grade C or better:  
 ENG 1003, ENG 1013, MATH 1023/1043^, COMS 1203, TE 2003
- ◆ ACT Reading & Math  $\geq$  19, Writing  $\geq$  7 and/or  
 Praxis CORE Reading, Math, and Writing  $\geq$  162
- ◆ Completion of Dispositions Assessment (EDA)
- ◆ Completion of Application for Admission with all required documentation (completed with academic advisor)
- ◆ Make an appointment for and successfully complete department screening interview
